

What used to make bath time "lots of fun" has recently creeped me out.

It was impossible to miss... toys. Something like half a dozen of them, all different colors, lined up on the dashboard of the vehicle next to me. The driver looked like the type of person who would try to bring a bit of flair to everyone around her. It was probably just her style.

Nope.

Days later, a different person pulled up behind my car. Same thing. She had a bunch of multi-colored rubber duckies organized in a row next to her windshield. Why? Maybe the last time she drove into a pond she thought, "Well, this isn't much fun." A new idea was born. Was she mamma duck, leading them home? Why would anyone want to be a part of some weird duck-toy-clan, and display it on their car?

Days later, a full grown man with a beard drove past me... toy ducks across his dashboard. No. Just... no. Do they match the bucket of candy he keeps in the trunk next to the duct tape?




It's not just Fremont. A friend of mine called me from halfway across the nation. "Dude, I had to call you. Someone put a toy duck on my car. Why in the world would anyone put a duck on my car? I think someone is trying to mess with me." He didn't know what to do, so he threw the duck into nearby bushes and sped away quickly. Three weeks later, same thing- duck on his car. His first thought? Stalker. "Why would anyone duck my car twice in a month!? Who is doing this to me!?"


YOUTH SUNDAY SCHOOL

Many great questions were raised at the meeting regarding choices of denominations, inclusion, decision making, pastoral role, how to grow our church, and discerning our goals.

Some next steps were determined including educating the congregation regarding finances and other "State of the Church" items, establishing a Statement of Beliefs to help guide the decision making process, forming a sub-committee to explore independent models, and finding answers to the questions that were raised.
