“Donde estoy? ”

Jason, reached across the table and handed me a menu, “Do the top two items look good to you?”

“Sure.”

It was in German. I don't know German. However, I am proud to announce that after 4 years of foreign language classes, I'm able to find the bathroom in Spain. I had no idea what I just ordered. When the waitress brought it out, I still didn't know exactly what it was. Meat?

A good friend of mine invited me to visit Europe with a handful of his friends for his 50th birthday. All of the other attendees were world-traveling Americans. I've been to Indiana. That's almost the same as “India.” Essentially, it's India PLUS, so pretty exotic.

Before I went to Europe, it was explained to me that many people there speak English, and I would be fine. I wasn't. At one point, I walked into a coffee shop and was thrilled to feel at home. I end up with a beer that I didn't know they sold.

To be fair, many people did speak English. English with an accent, which sounds a lot like not English. Good news though, as I tried to communicate with others, their body language clearly spoke “unimpressed” in every country I visited.

This is how I figured out how to best manage my language problem. When I was with my group of new friends at restaurants, I listened to what other members of the group ordered, then I ordered exactly what one of them purchased. I would say something like, “That sounds good, Adam. I'll have the same.” Then without fail, someone at the table would simply look at the waiter and say, “same” in whatever language was required. This was great on two points. First, I avoided awkwardness at the cost of knowing what I was ordering and second, my food was always an adventure.

Sometimes, it's best to choose someone you trust and simply follow. Even leaders follow someone. I'll see people who have that “something” that I know I don't and I'll just ask, “How did you develop that?” Many times they'll tell me about some experience they've had- one I would never consider doing on my own, that refined them. Other times, people will give me a road map of sorts, “The first thing you need to do is go to this website.” When I get there I'll surely “ingest” thoughts I never before considered.

In Jesus' day disciples were supposed to “walk in the dust of their rabbi's shoes” to learn. Jesus used that same approach to train his disciples. They went places they never could have imagined, and learned things that were so transformative that they changed the world. He invites you to do the same. If you have the will, he'll show the way by His Spirit, His Word, and other believers. You never know what you might absorb. In the middle of your travels you may ask, “Donde estoy?” Which means, “Where am I?” It will be right where you belong.



Easter Sunrise Breakfast


The Youth and Young Adults will be hosting an Easter Sunrise Breakfast again this year, which will follow the 7:00 am Sunrise Service.


