“Old Dog”

My wife and I are terrible at planning getaways. We just hit our 25 year anniversary and hoped to get away for 2 days. The day came. We left our house, then asked, “Where do you want to go?” We ended up in downtown Kalamazoo, Michigan.

That Thursday evening we decided to get dinner at the “Old Dog Tavern” about 4 blocks away. Online it looked like a great place to sit, in a fairly quiet environment, get a pizza and have a nice conversation. That’s not how it went exactly. There were “signs.” I ignored them.

We walked 4 blocks and arrived in front of the tavern where we were greeted by a nice young man. His hair extended into the sky like lightning rods, “Thank you for being here! Enjoy the show!” What show? Why was he in a sleeveless shirt? Was he even old enough to get into the “Old Dog?” I didn’t know exactly how to respond, so I thanked him and said, “Will do!”

We entered the front door. Why was there a bouncer? “You here for the show?” After 4 blocks, and thanking the young man out front, I felt like I was already committed, “Uh... yep. Is the show where the food is at? If so, then, ‘Yes.’” He put wrist bands on us.

After walking down a short hallway, we entered into a new world. It was like Gen Z invaded a fisherman’s lodge to throw a rave party. A live DJ was laying down beats while people pumped their hands in the air under a stuffed moose head. Lights flashed across the room. The sound was loud enough to make conversation near impossible.

A bartender in a low cut crop top took our pizza order and we sat down. I immediately began looking for an escape. I noticed patio seating just outside. Surely, it could save us. We moved outdoors. The young men at the table close to us started yelling obscenities at each other. Minutes later we heard a low chugging noise. It was a train- the slowest of trains. It crept past the patio at speeds barely recognizable to the human eye... horn on full blast. The pizza disappeared quickly. So did we.

That night I had a sudden realization- I was the old dog.

The show has its place. The hype has its place. I look back on my life and feel like I’ve been able to experience these in some incredible ways. They’re great. I’m sure I’ll enjoy more moments like this in the future. However, as I get older, I find that I want to connect less with what is immediately presented- the show and the hype, and more with what is underneath it all. I long for less “persona” or “mask,” and more for deep and real.

Connecting with Christ, the truth, the creator and logos of all things is as deep as understanding gets. Quiet moments in the scripture and in prayer that resonate at a personal, spiritual level is like drinking life-giving water that continually refreshes and sustains. It’s not hype that dies when the show ends. It’s permanent, steady and enduring.

If you find yourself tired of living in a world of show, seek Jesus.

They also installed a floor vent and trim in the bedroom, adjusted her exterior doors, fixed her bathroom faucet and 2 light fixtures.

A team from New Jersey served with them this week and our team spent some time outside helping fill in the drainage ditch with gravel.

Children's Church will return in the fall.

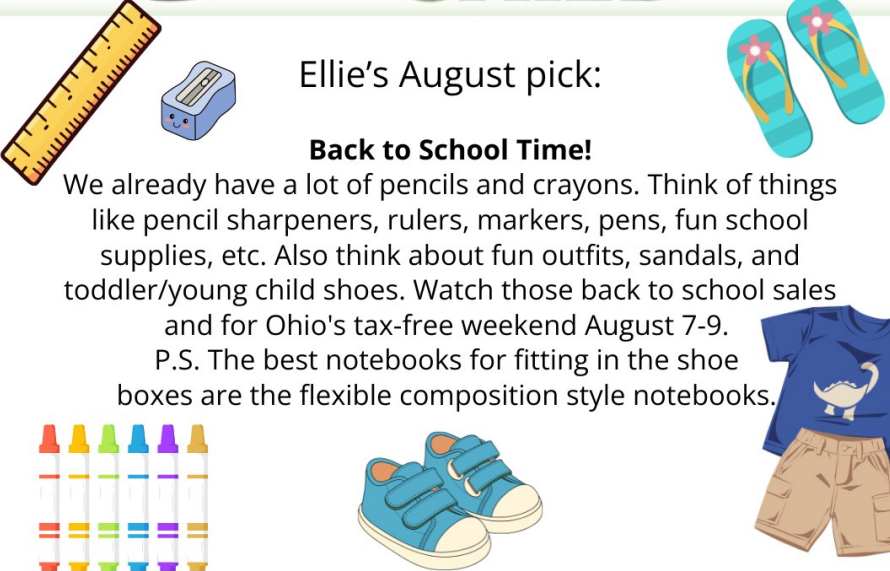
Nursery Available All Summer!
